Dear Parents,

In an effort to explore the uniqueness of all students, each child will be featured as the “Star of the Week.” This is the primary form of “share time” in 2nd grade. While your child is the “Star of the Week,” most days will consist of an exciting event or activity to honor him or her and to help us get to know our special classmate. Here is a schedule of the week’s activities:

Monday: “All About Me Tee” Poster Share: As Star of the Week, each child will be given an “All About Me Tee” poster to complete. This poster will be given to them two weeks prior to their special week. They may choose to add to his or her poster by including pictures or special drawings. Feel free to get creative and personalize the poster however they would like!

Tuesday: *Favorite Book*: The Star Student brings one of his or her favorite books to share and have the teacher read it to the class.

Wednesday: *Treasured Trinkets*: Please help your child in collecting up to 5 special items from home and send them to school to be shared with the class. The items need to fit in a grocery size bag. Remember these items should be ones that are special to your child. They should be prepared to discuss exactly why these items are important to them.

Thursday: *Five Fun Facts*: The Star of the Week will bring in five fun and interesting facts about him or her. The facts should be written on an index card. The Star of the Week will share them with the class and answer questions during the presentation.

Friday: *Star Letters*: On this last day of fun, the students in room 14 will draft letters addressed to the Star of the Week. The letters will be bound in a Star of the Week book and sent home when they are assembled. These books are a wonderful keepsake of 2nd grade.

Please look at the attached Star of the Week schedule. This should help you and your child to prepare for his/her turn. If you have any questions or concerns, please don’t hesitate to ask. **If by chance your child misses his/her week. They will be moved to a week at the end of the schedule.**

Throughout the week, your child will feel extra special each day. You may want to do something extra special for your child that week. This might include notes in his or her lunch or even joining them for lunch. I know your child will LOVE this fun-filled week!
